IOM is committed to a diverse and inclusive environment. Internal and external candidates are eligible to apply to this vacancy. For the purpose of the vacancy, internal candidates are considered as first-tier candidates.

Context:

Working under the overall supervision of the Resource Management Officer and the direct supervision of the National Finance Officer, the successful candidate will perform treasury functions and assist on financial project monitoring and reporting for the IOM Programmes in Nigeria. In particular, s/he will

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

- Receive invoices and payment requests and verify that transactions comply with IOM policies and procedures;
- Ensure that the financial transactions are recorded in accordance with the organization accounting system and procedures;
- Verify and ensure that all Travel Authorizations processed in the mission are in accordance with the applicable IOM policy;
- Assist in monitoring open commitments and clearing of mission vendor accounts; follow up with responsible Units on clearance of outstanding payables;
- Process personal deductions for staff in the accounting system;
- Maintain accurate records of entries in the accounting system for the assigned roles;
- Assist in the analysis of expenditures and variations within projects. Bring to the attention of the supervisor any relevant financial and budgetary issues on an ongoing basis;
- Assist in the preparation and revision of budgets for mission projects; assist in the preparation of donor financial reports;
- Provide accounting support and advice to sub-offices' finance staff as necessary for efficient operation at the sub-office level; undertake field visits to sub-offices when required;
- Perform other duties as may be required.

Required Qualifications and Experience

- University Degree / Certificate from an accredited academic institution in Accounting or Business Administration and At least five years of relevant working experience; experience with another international organization and knowledge of SAP an advantage.
- Minimum Four Years (two Years for Degree Holders) in related field; preferably within the United Nations and the International Humanitarian Field and knowledge of SAP an advantage.
- Excellent communication and negotiation skills;
- Ability to present clear and concise information;
- Ability to work effectively and harmoniously with colleagues from varied cultures and professional backgrounds;
- Ability to meet deadlines and work under pressure;
- Good level of computer literacy; personal commitment, efficiency, flexibility, drive for results.
