Context:

Under the general supervision of the IOM Chief of Mission for administrative matters, and the direct supervision of the Chief Migration Health Physician of the IOM Abuja office for technical matters, the Consultant National Migration Health Physician (On Call) will be responsible to support the migration health assessment activities at the IOM MHAC Abuja as and when required, in particular, he/she will:

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

1. Receive and identify applicants using their international passports;
2. Take history and perform physical examination according to the Technical Instructions;
3. Provide relevant information on possible outcomes of the chest radiographs and procedures involved in TB investigations;
4. Counsel applicants with chest x-ray findings of significant medical conditions;
5. Counsel applicants diagnosed with tuberculosis and refer for treatment as appropriate;
6. Counsel family contacts of applicants diagnosed with infectious tuberculosis for further investigation;
7. Any other duties assigned by the supervisor

Required Qualifications and Experience

- Medical doctor with a valid licence to practice in Nigeria,
- At least 3 years of work experience post-graduation,
- Good computer literacy,
- Flexible work schedule and be ready to be engaged on short notice.
