Context:

Working under the direct supervision of the Migration Health Officer, the incumbent will support the provision of medical radiological examination services for applicants examined at the IOM Migration Health Assessment Centre in Lagos. The incumbent will:

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

- Check, identify and register applicants referred for chest x-ray accurately according to the Standard Operating Procedures,
- Explain x-ray procedures including pregnancy enquiry and perform chest x-rays,
- Ensure x-ray is taken according to the Standard Operating Procedures,
- Perform additional chest x-ray views as requested by the radiologist,
- Maintain safety procedures during x-ray,
- Ensure self-protection and protection of staff and applicants from radiation.

Required Qualifications and Experience

- At least a Diploma in radiology from an accredited academic institution;
- At least four years of continuous practice post-graduation, registered to practice in Nigeria and with a valid registration license.

Fluency in **English** and Native Language; Fluency in all languages advantageous;
