Context:

Working under the overall supervision of the overall supervision of Programme Manager (MM/AVRR) and the direct supervision of the National Programme Officer (MM), the staff will contribute to the implementation of the European Union Trust Fund (EUTF) project "Strengthening Migration Governance in Nigeria and Sustainable Reintegration of Returning Migrants", with special focus on strengthening the labour migration governance and diaspora component of the project, he/she will:

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

1. Support the implementation of project in areas such as migration management, labour migration, border management strategy and Diaspora policy development.
2. Implement the plan of activities of the project(s) under direct coordination of the supervisor, coordinate day to day activities and administrative processes; report regularly on the challenges and progress recorded in realisation of activities; consult with the project partners and revise planning of activities as appropriate to meet changing needs and requirements and keep donor representatives briefed on
3. Assist in timely implementation and reporting on project activities according to IOM and donor formats as required, contribute to and/or prepare weekly progress updates on project activities.
4. Assist with in-house coordination among different sections of the project and proper documentation of project documents and filing.
5. Contribute to ensuring delivery of quality thematic training to government as required by the project.
6. Track project expenditure for the Labour Migration and Diaspora Mobilization component, serve as focal point for administrative coordination of program implementation activities, involving extensive liaison with other organizational units.

7. Support liaison and coordination with relevant governmental and non-governmental entities, international organizations as well as other relevant stakeholders where necessary for effective implementation of the activities of project and represent IOM at coordination meetings with governments, NGOs and other stakeholders where required.
8. Research, compile and present information on developments on new trends and policies in the field of migration in the country (including labour migration information) for successful implementation of the project activities
9. Assist in the planning, preparation and implementation of seminars, conferences, workshops, meetings, presentations and missions related to the project, undertake duty travel when necessary;
10. Support the development of tracking tools based on agreed indicators for tracking the implementation of pilot projects.
11. Support the development of new projects based on identified needs during project implementation;
12. Facilitate functioning systems to promote programme visibility, support the development of preparation and printing of PI materials.
13. Perform any other duties as may be assigned.

Required Qualifications and Experience

- Completed University degree from an accredited institution in International Relations, Social Science, Law, Humanitarian Affairs or related field;
- Minimum of three years (or five years of experience for candidates holding a first level university degree) in the field of migration issues including operational and field experience.
- Project management experience required, preferably in migration and/or labour management capacity building.
- Good knowledge of project development, administration and evaluation concepts and procedures.
- Work experience related to migration, diaspora mobilization and especially government institutions capacity building programs desirable
- Proven ability to establish and maintain strong working relations with relevant Government counterparts, international organizations and private sector entities.
- Demonstrated proficiency with Microsoft Office applications, including Excel, PowerPoint, Good knowledge of information technology and proficiency in Microsoft Office applications especially Excel, Word, PowerPoint, Publisher, and SharePoint.
- Experience of supporting all aspects of project management and familiarity with international standards and EU regulations a plus;
