**WHO**

There are 54 distinct actors who aided across the 78 IOM managed sites. 41 of these actors assisted in Borno state while 13 assisted in Adamawa state.

**WHAT**

10 distinct sectoral assistance – Camp Coordination and Camp Management [2 agencies], Non-Food Items [5 agencies], Shelter [10 agencies], WASH [18 agencies], Livelihood [9 agencies], Protection [32 agencies], Health [14 agencies], Food Security [10 agencies], Education [9 agencies], and Nutrition [13 agencies] were provided through the reporting period.

**WHERE**

These assistances were provided across 78 IDP sites and 9 Host Community locations in Adamawa and Borno states.

**WHOM**

Internally Displaced Persons (New arrivals and Returnees inclusive) [77.8%] and some inhabitants in Host Communities [22.2%] were the beneficiaries of the assistance provided.

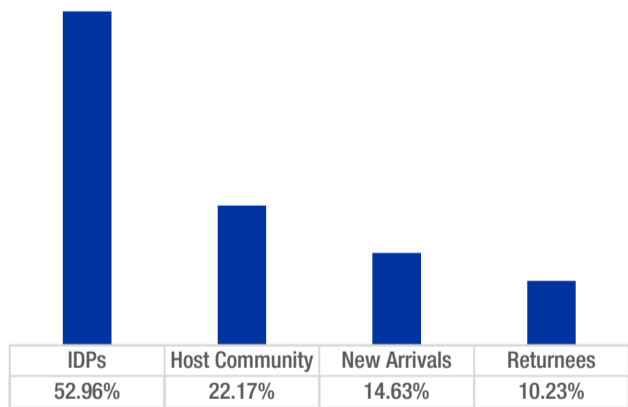


Fig 1.2 Shows reached population across sites and Host communities

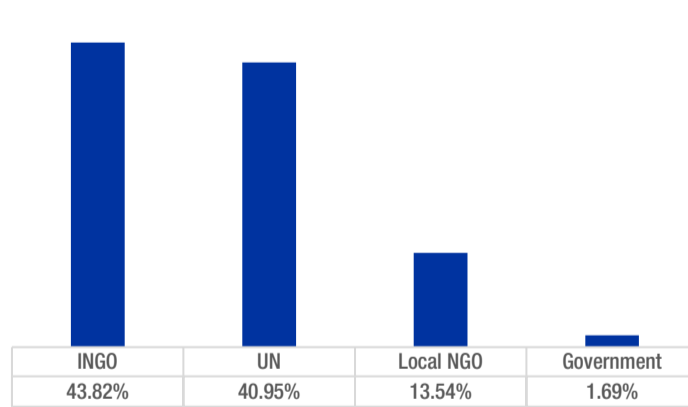


Fig 1.3 Show involvement of All NGO types in IOM CCCM Camps.
