WHO

There are 55 distinct actors who aided across the 78 IOM managed sites. 50 of these actors assisted in Borno state while 17 assisted in Adamawa state.

WHAT

10 distinct sectoral assistance – Camp Coordination and Camp Management [2 agencies], Non-Food Items [5 agencies], Shelter [10 agencies], WASH [21 agencies], Livelihood [8 agencies], Protection [32 agencies], Health [13 agencies], Food Security [10 agencies], Education [9 agencies], and Nutrition [13 agencies] were provided through the reporting period. *An increase of +2% compared to the previous reporting month (February)*

WHERE

These assistances were provided across 78 IDP sites and 9 Host Community locations in Adamawa and Borno states.

WHOM

Internally Displaced Persons (New arrivals and Returnees inclusive) [82%] and some inhabitants in Host Communities [18%] were the beneficiaries of the assistance provided. *An increase of +4% compared to the previous reporting month (February)*

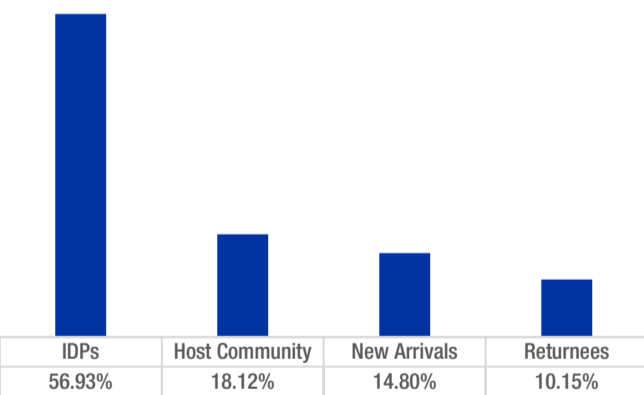


Fig 1.2 Shows reached population across sites and Host communities

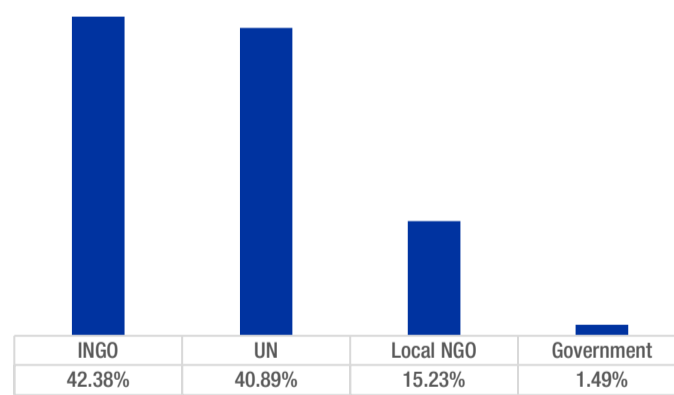


Fig 1.3 Show involvement of All NGO types in IOM CCCM Camps.
