C. Detailed Examination of Bids (Financial Examination)

Only the Financial Proposal of bidders that obtain overall Pass in the Preliminary evaluation and a minimum of 70% in technical evaluation shall undergo the financial evaluation.

The financial evaluation accounts for 30 points (30%) out of the total combined score (technical + financial) of 100 points.

The lowest Financial Proposal (F1) shall be given a financial score (Sf) of 100 points.

The financial scores (Sf) of the other Financial Proposals shall be computed based on the formula:

Sf = 100 xF1/F

Where:

- Sf is the financial score of the Financial Proposal under consideration,
- **F1** is the price of the lowest Financial Proposal, and
- **F** is the price of the Financial Proposal under consideration.

The proposals shall then be ranked according to their combined (Sc) technical (St) and financial (Sf) scores using the weights.

(T = the weight given to the Technical Proposal = 0.70; F = the weight given to the Financial Proposal = 0.30; T + F = 1).
