REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The International Organization for Migration (IOM), the UN Migration Agency in Nigeria is currently implementing the European Union (EU) and IOM Initiative on Migration Governance and Reintegration in Nigeria with funding from the EU. The project seeks to amongst other things support the Government of Nigeria to improve the governance of migration through the development of migration strategies and implementation of migration policies; improve the reintegration of returning migrants; strengthen national structures and capabilities in terms of managing reintegration in a dignified and sustainable manner.

IOM has launched a call for Concept Notes for registered Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) in Nigeria working on migration for the award of grants for implementation of the National Migration Policy Action Plan within the framework of the project. Eligible institutions (*) are hereby invited to submit Proposals on the below priority areas:

- i. Capacity building of border operatives on migrant protection at Seme (Lagos), Jibiya (Katsina) and Mfum (Cross River) borders.
- ii. Capacity building for Media practitioners on Migration Reportage

- Non-governmental organizations;
- Coalition of Organizations; and
- Migrants Associations
