IOM is committed to a diverse and inclusive environment. Internal and external candidates are eligible to apply to this vacancy. For the purpose of the vacancy, internal candidates are considered as first-tier candidates.

### ***Context:***

Under the overall supervision of the DTM Project Officer in Nigeria and under the direct supervision of the Field Operation Assistants, the successful candidate will be accountable and responsible for collecting data as part of the Displacement Tracking (ETT, MT, BR). S/he will work in close collaboration with the partners on the field in the areas (s) s/he has been assigned to. He/she will perform the underlisted functions;

### **Core Functions/Responsibilities:**

1. Collect data and provide support to relevant partners on data collection based on the DTM methodology and tools following a pre-established schedule.
2. Monitor and evaluate the DTM operations, identifying areas of improvement and enhanced efficiency.
3. Be responsible for sending the information collected on the field to the Field Operation Assistant on a timely manner and according to the standards and requirement of the DTM program.
4. Triangulating collected data based on DTM methodology with relevant partners
5. Carrying out rapid registration where needed.
6. Perform such other duties as may be assigned

## ***Required Qualifications and Experience***

- Certificate / Diploma / Degree in relevant field;

- Experience in the field of humanitarian assistance is an advantage
- Experience in data collection and statistic is an advantage
- Minimum of two years for university diploma or a year for degree
- Experience in humanitarian field, NGO, INGO is mandatory
- Demonstrated ability to maintain integrity in performing responsibility assigned
- Trusted by the community, with certain maturity in making decisions, widely accepted, respected
- Possess good leadership skills and ability to explain instructions clearly
